APPLICATION PROCEDURES & DEADLINES

For Summer 2019, the Human Development Summer Program will run from JULY 14, 2019 to JULY 28, 2019

APPLICATION DEADLINE: February 1, 2019

FEES DEADLINE

Application Fee (non-refundable): \$200 CAD to be paid at time of application submission

Non-Refundable Deposit: \$1,000 CAD to be paid two weeks after admission notification

All Remaining Fees: April 15th, 2019

PROGRAM COST

\$2,000 CAD per student (includes tuition, materials, medical insurance, group airport transfers, city tour, orientation and farewell, onsite translator, and some social events)

Minimum of 15 students per group.

DOES NOT INCLUDE airfare, accommodation, or meals.

ACCOMMODATION COST (based on 2018/19 rates)

- ** 45-50 CAD per day plus 13% tax. Meal plans for purchase e.g. 20 MEALS \$ 190.00 + 13% HST (other options available)
- *** 139 CAD per day, per single (one person) or double room (two people) plus 13% taxes per night; includes a full buffet breakfast. For a double room this works out to \$69.50 per person plus HST.
